3 **WHEREAS**, Nick Delgado is an award-winning journalist who began his career
4 in broadcast journalism in 2006 and joined the KUAM News team in 2009, and for
5 more than 18 years has worked tirelessly in various forms of media including broadcast,
6 print, and digital news across Guam, Central Texas, New York, and New Jersey; and

7 **WHEREAS**, throughout his impressive journalism career, Nick has focused
8 primarily on crime and court reporting, investigative journalism, and community-driven
9 storytelling, earning the respect of his colleagues, viewers, and readers alike; and

10 **WHEREAS**, his investigative reporting on illegal massage parlors operating as
11 brothels in Guam prompted the formation of a multi-agency government task force,
12 demonstrating the real-world impact and accountability journalism can bring to light;
13 and

1 **WHEREAS**, Nick was one of the first reporters on-scene during the tragic 2009
2 shooting at Fort Hood, Texas that left four dead, including the gunman, and his team's
3 coverage—along with their retrospective television special on the 5-year anniversary—
4 earned a Lone Star Emmy and multiple Texas Associated Press awards; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Nick’s journalistic assignments have taken him around the world,
6 reporting from the Philippines, Belgium, and the Mexican border, further showcasing
7 his versatility and commitment to telling compelling, human-centered stories; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in 2024, Nick proudly represented Guam and the Micronesian
9 region by covering the Summer Olympics in Paris, France, highlighting the athletes and
10 stories of Pacific Islanders on the international stage; and

11 **WHEREAS**, beyond the newsroom, Nick has given back to the community by
12 volunteering for Special Olympics Guam, participating in Giving Tuesday campaigns,
13 and supporting fundraisers to help the homeless population; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Nick currently serves as the Managing Director of News Strategy
15 and Development for KUAM Communications, while also anchoring the station’s
16 Primetime newscast and continuing to produce high-impact coverage that informs and
17 empowers the people of Guam; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Nick's unwavering dedication, keen journalistic instincts, and heart
19 for community service have made him a trusted source for news and a respected voice
20 in the island's media landscape; and

21 **WHEREAS**, as Nick embarks on a new chapter in his life to be closer to his
22 children—Kevin, Qurtis, and Quinn—he leaves behind a lasting legacy and standard of
23 excellence for future journalists in Guam and Micronesia; now therefore, be it

24 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Ocho Na*
25 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
26 of Guam, commend and congratulate Mr. Nick Delgado for his exemplary service to
