BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I*MINA'TRENTALOCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Florence Paulino Shimizu has been an active member in good standing with the Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association (GMHVA) since 2008, and as of December 2024, met the requirements for Lifetime Membership by completing fifteen (15) years of service and contributing over five thousand (5,000) volunteer hours; and

WHEREAS, Florence has served in leadership roles within GMHVA, including as a member of the Board of Directors and Acting Recording Secretary from 2013 to 2014, significantly contributing to the success of GMHVA's mission to support Guam Memorial Hospital (GMH) and its patients through various services, comfort, and

financial assistance for essential equipment, furnishings, and programs; and

1 WHEREAS, Florence received the United States President's Volunteer Service 2 Award Certificate and Pin in recognition of her over 4,000 hours of volunteer service 3 to GMHVA; and 4 WHEREAS, Florence has generously offered her time, energy, skills, and 5 encouragement to assist patients and their families without expectation of reward; and 6 WHEREAS, Florence has remained a steadfast supporter of GMHVA over the 7 years, continuing to serve on Standing Committees—primarily the Membership 8 Committee—helping achieve the committee's goals and objectives; and 9 WHEREAS, Florence has faithfully contributed to GMHVA's charitable 10 initiatives, including fundraising efforts and grant attainment; she has assisted in the 11 operation of the Gift Shop as a cashier and sales associate, managed merchandise 12 inventory and pricing, conducted new volunteer orientations, and provided support 13 through the Gift Cart service, spiritual support offerings, and newspaper delivery to 14 nursing wards; and 15 **WHEREAS**, she has additionally provided coverage at the Hospital Lobby 16 Information Center in the absence of other volunteers, accompanied volunteers for 17 newborn photography, contributed to the Quarterly Volunteer Newsletter, participated 18 in the publication of two (2) GMHVA Cookbooks, and actively supported a wide array 19 of events, including the Membership Drive Tea, National Volunteer Week activities, 20 Charity Ball, Christmas Bazaar, Rummage and Bake Sales, Plant and Book Sales, 21 Thanksgiving Raffle, Macy's "Shop for a Cause," Three Kings Caroling and Gift 22 Giving at the Skilled Nursing Unit and hospital wards, Installation and Recognition of 23 Volunteers and Officers, and Volunteer Awards Day; and 24 **WHEREAS**, Florence has regularly attended GMH Chapel Services and funeral 25 services for deceased volunteers and their families, participated in quarterly general 26 membership meetings and birthday celebrations, and remained engaged through 27

executive and subcommittee meetings, education, and training; and

1 WHEREAS, Florence's educational background includes high school studies at 2 St. Francis and George Washington Senior High School, and higher education at the 3 University of Guam and San Jose State University, where she earned a Master's Degree in Social Work. Her extensive professional experience in government and non-4 5 governmental human services programs has equipped her with invaluable skills in the 6 helping profession; and 7 WHEREAS, Florence's distinguished career includes service as an Eligibility 8 Worker at the Department of Public Health and Social Services, Medical Social Worker 9 at Santa Clara, Good Samaritan, and Santa Teresa Hospitals in California, and roles at 10 GMH's Medical Services Division. She later served as Social Worker/Supervisor in the Crippled Children's Services Unit, Administrator for Maternal Child Health Services 11 and the Medically Indigent Program, and Administrator of the Division of Senior 12 Citizens. As Senior Citizens Division Administrator, she contributed to the 13 14 establishment of the St. Dominic's Senior Care Facility in Barrigada Heights as part of 15 the Long-Term Planning Committee led by Dr. Ulla Craig of UOG; and 16 WHEREAS, following her retirement from public service, Florence continued to serve the island community through employment with the Department of Education, 17 18 the Diocesan Resettlement Program (resettlement of Vietnamese refugees), the Catholic 19 Radio Station, St. John's Bookstore, and Almy's Department Store; and 20 WHEREAS, Florence's enduring dedication to community service includes 21 active involvement in the GMHVA, the Archdiocese of Hagåtña's San Jose and San Isidro Parishes, the Guam Association of Social Workers—where she was honored as 22 23 the first "Social Worker of the Year"—as well as affiliations with the World Health Organization Fellowship Program, Inetnon Famalao'an, the U.S. Census, the American 24 Red Cross (San Jose), the University of Guam Student Council, Choir, Cultural Dance 25 26 Troupe, and the Inalåhan Gef Pa'go Chamoru Village; and

1 WHEREAS, Florence Paulino Shimizu, affectionately known as "Darling" to her family and "Flo" to the island community, was born on November 1, 1949, to the 2 3 late Tan Floren Meno and Tun Vicente Duenas Paulino. Upon returning to Guam from 4 the United States, she was raised in the southern village of Inalåhan.
