



KIRSTA L. BLANKENSHIP, NOMINEE: NO THE I'M A FULL-TIME PHARMACIST AT MEGA DRUG AND WHEN THEY NEED SOMEBODY TO FILL IN AT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH BECAUSE THAT PHARMACIST IS ON VACATION I'LL PICK UP SOME HOURS THERE I DON'T KNOW IF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH IS PART OF GMH

SENATOR THERESE M. TERLAJE: NO ALL RIGHT OKAY I WANTED TO KNOW THAT BECAUSE I'M FINDING THAT WE DO HAVE SEVERAL BOARD MEMBERS OF THE TRUSTEES WHO ACTUALLY ARE EITHER ON CONTRACT OR WORK FOR GMH AND BUT I'M GLAD THAT THAT'S THE SITUATION WITH YOU WHEN YOU SAID THAT WE SHOULD BE USING THE PMP TO COMBAT OR TO ASSIST IN THE WAR ON DRUGS IS THAT NOT BEING USED AT GMH

BLANKENSHIP, NOMINEE: OH OKAY SO IT'S A PRESCRIPTION MONITORING PROGRAM THAT IS ONLINE FOR THE ISLAND OF GUAM WE CAN ALSO LOOK UP HAWAII AND THE MILITARY SERVICES IT SHOWS WHAT MEDICATIONS OR CONTROL SUBSTANCES IF WE LOOK UP THE PATIENT IT'LL SHOW YOU EXACTLY WHAT THEY'VE GOTTEN WHEN THEY'VE GOTTEN WHAT PHARMACY WHAT DOCTOR SO WE CAN TRACK AND SAY OH THIS PERSON'S GOT A PROBLEM SO WE SHOULD CALL THAT DOCTOR AND LET THEM KNOW AND PERHAPS VOID THIS PRESCRIPTION

SENATOR THERESE M. TERLAJE: THANK YOU DO YOU HAVE ANY PROBLEM AS A IF YOU WERE ON THE BOARD TO BE TO ANSWER TO THE LEGISLATURE WHEN THERE ARE ISSUES WITH GMH

KIRSTA L. BLANKENSHIP, NOMINEE: NO BECAUSE I BELIEVE IN ACCOUNTABILITY IF SOMEONE HAS A QUESTION I BELIEVE IN TRANSPARENCY ANSWERING THAT QUESTION AND HAVING THINGS OUT IN THE OPEN

SENATOR THERESE M. TERLAJE: I APPRECIATE THAT ALMOST ALWAYS OUR HEARINGS WE HAVE THE ADMINISTRATION REPRESENTED BUT VERY RARELY ARE ANY BOARD MEMBERS HERE EXCEPT FOR OF COURSE WE HAVE THE CHIEF MEDICAL OFFICER BUT THOSE ARE ALL MANAGEMENT AT THE HOSPITAL SO I APPRECIATE THAT AND IF YOU WOULD CONSIDER THAT I THINK WHEN IT'S NECESSARY OR YOU THINK IT WOULD BE HELPFUL THERE'S SEVERAL THINGS

KIRSTA L. BLANKENSHIP, NOMINEE: I THINK THAT PEOPLE SHOULD BE HIRED BASED ON MANAGEMENT MERIT AND ABILITY AND I THINK I'M HOPING THAT IN THAT RECRUITMENT OR HIREMENT I'M REALLY HOPING THAT THAT WAS TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION BUT I THINK YOU SHOULD PROVE YOURSELF IN YOUR JOB TO BE PROMOTED
