

WOULD YOU BE ABLE TO BE OBJECTIVE IN YOUR REVIEW OF THEIR RENEWALS AND COMPLAINTS AGAINST THEM

MAY CAMACHO FEEL THAT I CAN BE. UM, I'VE KNOWN MANY OF THEM FOR MANY, MANY YEARS. UM, I'VE ALWAYS, UM, BEEN ON THEM TO MAKE SURE THAT THEY'RE, YOU KNOW, UP TO DATE IN THEIR, UH, ASHA, UH, GUIDELINES AND AND THINGS LIKE THAT. UM, SO I MEAN I DO KNOW LIKE I SAID I DO KNOW THE MAJORITY OF THE PRACTITIONERS ON ISLAND AND THAT'S UH BECAUSE THE MAJORITY OF THEM ARE EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. I TEND TO LOOK INTO SMALL DETAILS AND I'M THE PERSON WHO READS EVERY LINE AND TICK MARKS EVERY LISENATOR THERESE TERLAJELE THING JUST TO MAKE SURE THAT WE'RE NOT MISSING ANYTHING. I THINK THAT'S VERY IMPORTANT ESPECIALLY IN THE CONVERSATION ABOUT INTERNATIONALLY TRAINED PHYSICIANS. I THINK IT IS THE SAME WITH ANY PHYSICIAN THAT WE COME TO GUAM. , YOU KNOW, GUAM IS SUCH AN UNUSUAL LOCATION. WE STILL HAVE TO BE AMERICAN PHYSICIANS WITH AMERICAN TRAINING, AT LEAST CURRENTLY. , AND YET WE'RE SO FAR AWAY. PEOPLE WOULD HAVE TO HAVE A REASON TO MOVE HERE. , AND I THINK THAT'S TRUE FOR MOST PEOPLE MOVING TO GUAM. BUT THEN THE NEXT QUESTION IS ARE YOU SOMEONE WHO I WOULD WANT TO WORK WITH AND TAKING CARE OF MY FAMILY, MY FRIENDS AND OUR EXTENDED FRIENDS AND FAMILY NETWORK HERE ON GUAM BECAUSE REALLY THERE'S ONLY ONE OR TWO DEGREE OF SEPARATION. SO I THINK IT'S VERY IMPORTANT AS A MEDICAL BOARD MEMBER TO BE ABLE TO LOOK THROUGH EVERY SINGLE APPLICATION AND MAKE SURE THAT THIS IS SOMEONE THAT I WOULD WANT TO BE ON ISLAND TREATING MY FRIENDS AND FAMILY. NOW THE DEBATE ON THESE INTERNATIONALLY TRAINED PHYSICIANS IS A VERY INTERESTING DEBATE. YOU KNOW THERE ARE DIFFERENT C I I FEEL LIKE ALMOST EVERY COUNTRY HAS A SHORTAGE OF PHYSICIANS. I KNOW AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND ARE RAPIDLY RECRUITING AMERICAN PHYSICIANS. MANY AMERICANS ARE MOVING THERE. AMERICAN PHYSICIANS ARE ALSO MOVING INTO CANADA AND THE MIDDLE EAST AND THEY'RE ACTIVELY RECRUITING ALL OVER. AND SO IT CAUSES A BIGGER PHYSICIAN SHORTAGE THROUGHOUT OUR COUNTRY. AND IT MAKES IT EVEN HARDER FOR US TO GET IN YOU KNOW AMERICAN PHYSICIANS TO COME TO GUAM. WITH THAT SAID, THERE ARE MANY COUNTRIES THAT HAVE THE ST SAME STANDARD OF CARE OR VERY SIMILAR STANDARD OF CARE TO MEDICINE IN THE US AND US MEDICINE IS ABSOLUTELY YOU KNOW ONE OF THE BEST IN THE WORLD AND WE TAKE VERY GOOD CARE OF OUR PATIENTS AND WE USE SCIENTIFIC DATA TO DECIDE ON WHAT WOULD BE THE APPROPRIATE NEXT CARE. I THINK JUST LOOKING THROUGH EVERY SINGLE PHYSICIAN WHO IS COMING TO GUAM, WHETHER THEY ARE INTERNATIONALLY TRAINED OR US TRAINED IS VERY IMPORTANT. , AND FINDING OUT WHERE THEIR QUALIFICATIONS ARE. YOU KNOW, WHEN I WAS IN RESIDENCY, IT WAS VERY INTERESTING. MOST OF OUR INTERNATIONAL GRADUATES CAME FROM TWO OR THREE DIFFERENT MEDICAL SCHOOLS IN THE WHY IS IT THAT WE'RE ONLY TAKING PHYSICIANS FROM THESE PROGRAMS? AND HE SAID, BECAUSE WE HAVE HAD EXCELLENT CARE, EXCELLENT TRAINED PHYSICIANS FROM THESE INSTITUTIONS AND WE KNOW WHAT THEIR STANDARDS ARE AND WE KNOW THEIR STANDARDS ARE VERY HIGH. AND SO WITH INTERNATIONALLY TRAINED PHYSICIANS, THE PROBLEM IS NOW WE HAVE HUNDREDS OF MEDICAL SCHOOLS, MAYBE THOUSANDS OF MEDICAL SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD TO DEAL WITH. WHAT IS YOUR POSITION? DO YOU BELIEVE THAT THE ITP PATHWAY SHOULD BE OPEN TO ALSO PRIVATE MEDICAL FACILITIES?

ERIKA ALFORD I BELIEVE SO. AND THE REASON FOR THAT IS IF YOU HAVE AN EQUIVALENT PHYSICIAN WHO IS ABLE TO SUPERVISE AN ITP INTERNATIONALLY TRAINED PHYSICIAN, I THINK THAT IS OKAY. YOU KNOW BUT IT SHOULD BE SOMEONE WHO IS OF THE SAME SPECIALTY. SO YOU DON'T WANT A GENERAL SURGEON SUPERVISING A SUPER SUB SPECIALIZED SURGEON LIKE A NEUROSURGEON YOU KNOW YOU DON'T WANT A FAMILY PRACTITIONER SUPERVISING A GASTRONUROLOGIST BECAUSE WHAT WE DO IS VERY DIFFERENT. WE MAY ALL BE PHYSICIANS BUT WHAT WE DO IS SO DIFFERENT THAT I MEAN I REGULARLY TELL MY PATIENTS I YOU KNOW THAT'S NOT MY FIELD OF EXPERTISE. I CANNOT GIVE YOU A GOOD OPINION ON IT. SO YOU NEED TO GO SEE YOU KNOW THIS PERSON INSTEAD. SO I THINK IF WE'RE GOING TO OPEN IT UP THERE DEFINITELY HAS TO BE SOME KIND OF SAFEGUARD MECHANISM TO MAKE SURE THAT THE SUPERVISING PHYSICIAN IS SOMEONE WHO SHOULD KNOW AS MUCH IF NOT MORE THAN THE PERSON WHO IS COMING IN. RIGHT.

ERIKA ALFORD SO I AM NOT EMPLOYED BY GMH BUT I DO TAKE CALL AND I HAVE PRIVILEGES AT GMH. OKAY.

SENATOR THERESE TERLAJE SO YEAH. SO DR. EUESEBIO AND YOU FROM GMH AND THEN DR. CRUZ AND YOU FROM AMC. ARE ON THE SAME BOARD. AND I GUESS I'M JUST A LIENATOR THERESE TERLAJELE BIT CONCERNED THAT DO WE HAVE A GOOD REPRESENTATION OF ALL THE DIFFERENT TYPES OF CLINICS AND DOCTORS HERE ON GUAM? AND SO, JUST PERSONALITY WISE, I THINK I'D HAVE A HARD TIME LESENATOR THERESE TERLAJEING THINGS LINGER. , I'M VERY GOOD AT LIGHTING FIRES UNDER PEOPLE TO GET THINGS DONE. THEY CALL ME WHEN HE'S OFF ISLAND OR IF IT'S ONE OF MY OWN PATIENTS. , SO I WORK WITH GMH PHYSICIANS. I DON'T BUT I ALSO TEND TO GO IN LATE AT NIGHT. , SO I DON'T HAVE MUCH OF A PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH MOST OF THEM. , OBVIOUSLY WITH SOME OF THE FEW LOCAL PHYSICIANS THAT I KNOW WELL ON A PERSONAL LEVEL. III. Findings and Recommendations

Guam's schools face a major shortage of speech and language pathologists, particularly for early intervention programs. This issue is worsened by inconsistencies in job classification and salary between teachers and certified pathologists, making it difficult to attract and keep qualified professionals. To address this, it is recommended that the Department of Education revise job classifications and compensation for speech-language pathologists and prioritize recruiting efforts to ensure these vital positions are filled.
