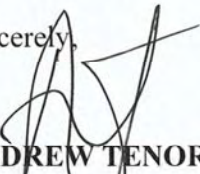

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee convened a public hearing on June 1, 2026, to consider the appointments of Michael W. Makio and Lynn Rosalie C. Leon Guerrero to serve on the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board (GHPRB).

The hearing focused on:

- Strengthening public participation in preservation decision-making
- Expanding preservation workforce development opportunities
- Increasing transparency and stakeholder engagement
- Improving preservation planning and policy implementation
- Ensuring long-term protection of Guam's cultural and historic resources

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The Committee on Child Welfare, Youth Affairs, Senior Citizens, Women's Affairs, Disability Services, the Arts, Culture, Historic Preservation, and Guam Restoration convened a public hearing on June 1, 2026, to consider appointments to the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board.

Testimony received during the hearing demonstrated broad support for both nominees and highlighted their extensive experience in architecture, archaeology, historic preservation, cultural resource management, and community engagement.

In addition to evaluating the qualifications of the nominees, committee discussion expanded to broader preservation-related issues affecting Guam, including public outreach, preservation planning, workforce development, federal policy changes, cultural resource protection, and balancing preservation priorities with economic development and infrastructure needs.

- Appointment of Michael W. Makio to the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board

III. TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

A. Opening Statement – Senator Shelly V. Calvo

Chairperson Calvo emphasized the critical role of the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board in protecting Guam's cultural identity, historic resources, ancestral legacy, and community heritage.

The Chair highlighted the importance of appointing qualified individuals who possess both professional expertise and a demonstrated commitment to safeguarding Guam's history and cultural resources for future generations.

The hearing was framed as an opportunity to evaluate the qualifications of the nominees while examining the broader responsibilities of preservation leadership within the community.

B. Testimony Supporting Michael W. Makio

Joe Quinata, former Chief Program Officer of the Guam Preservation Trust, testified in support of Mr. Makio, describing him as a respected leader with extensive experience in preservation governance and policy development.

Mr. Quinata highlighted Makio's contributions to the growth and success of the Guam Preservation Trust and his ability to address preservation issues with professionalism, neutrality, and sound judgment.

Andrew Tenorio, Interim Chief Program Officer of the Guam Preservation Trust, also testified in support of Mr. Makio, citing his architectural expertise, institutional knowledge, and longstanding commitment to preservation efforts throughout Guam.

Witnesses consistently characterized Mr. Makio as a knowledgeable and effective leader capable of continuing to guide preservation policy and community engagement efforts.

C. Testimony Supporting Lynn Rosalie C. Leon Guerrero

Joe Quinata testified that Ms. Leon Guerrero is among Guam's pioneering CHamoru archaeologists and has spent nearly three decades working in archaeology and cultural resource management.

Andrew Tenorio emphasized that Ms. Leon Guerrero's professional experience provides valuable expertise for the archaeology discipline seat and would strengthen the Board's ability to evaluate projects involving cultural and archaeological resources.

Michael Makio further testified in support of Ms. Leon Guerrero, describing her as an accomplished professional whose experience and perspective would be an asset to the Board.

Witnesses also highlighted her role as a positive example for younger professionals interested in archaeology, anthropology, and historic preservation.

D. Testimony of Lynn Rosalie C. Leon Guerrero

Ms. Leon Guerrero testified regarding her 28 years of experience as an archaeologist on Guam and throughout the CNMI.

She discussed her work in cultural resource management and emphasized the importance of collaboration among archaeologists, preservation professionals, developers, government agencies, and community stakeholders.

During her testimony and responses to senators' questions, Ms. Leon Guerrero stressed that successful preservation efforts require communication, compromise, transparency, and active engagement with the community.

She also expressed support for encouraging future generations to pursue careers in archaeology and cultural resource management.

E. Testimony of Michael W. Makio

Mr. Makio discussed the role of preservation organizations and emphasized the need for increased public outreach and engagement.

He noted that preservation agencies should actively seek community input rather than rely solely on public comment opportunities.

Mr. Makio also discussed the importance of Guam's Historic Preservation Plan, describing it as a critical policy document that should reflect community priorities and guide preservation efforts.

Additional testimony focused on strengthening preservation institutions, supporting workforce development, and improving communication between agencies and the communities they serve.

IV. KEY FINDINGS

1. Strong Support for Both Nominees

Testimony demonstrated broad support for both appointees. Witnesses consistently cited their professional expertise, leadership abilities, and commitment to preserving Guam's cultural and historic resources.

2. Public Outreach Remains a Significant Concern

Multiple participants emphasized the need for preservation agencies to actively engage the public and seek community input throughout preservation processes.

Witnesses expressed the view that meaningful preservation efforts require ongoing public education, communication, and participation.

3. Preservation Workforce Challenges Exist

The hearing highlighted concerns regarding recruitment and retention of archaeologists and preservation professionals.

Participants identified financial barriers, limited opportunities, and declining federal support as challenges affecting workforce development within preservation-related fields.

4. Historic Preservation Requires Stronger Community-Based Planning

Discussion emphasized the importance of regularly updating preservation planning documents and ensuring that community priorities are reflected in policy decisions.

5. Preservation and Development Must Be Balanced

Committee discussion reflected the ongoing challenge of balancing cultural resource protection with economic development, military projects, housing needs, infrastructure improvements, and community growth.

V. MAJOR POLICY THEMES

A. Community Engagement and Public Trust

Witnesses repeatedly emphasized that preservation efforts are most effective when communities are engaged early and meaningfully in decision-making processes.

Public trust was identified as a critical component of successful preservation initiatives.

B. Capacity of Preservation Institutions

Discussion highlighted concerns regarding staffing, funding, technical expertise, and institutional resources necessary to carry out preservation responsibilities effectively.

C. Future of Historic Preservation in Guam

Participants discussed the need to cultivate future generations of archaeologists, architects, historians, cultural practitioners, and preservation professionals.

D. Preservation Planning and Policy Direction

Witnesses emphasized the importance of maintaining clear preservation priorities, updating planning documents, and aligning preservation activities with community needs and expectations.

VI. COMMITTEE OBSERVATIONS

Based on testimony received during the hearing, the Committee observed several recurring themes:

- Community engagement remains essential to maintaining public trust in preservation processes.
- Preservation workforce development should be prioritized to address future staffing and expertise needs.
- Preservation agencies benefit from proactive outreach and education efforts.
- Strong collaboration among preservation organizations, government agencies, cultural practitioners, developers, and community stakeholders remains necessary to protect Guam's historic and cultural resources.
- Continued investment in preservation planning will help ensure that preservation priorities remain aligned with community values.

VII. LEGISLATIVE RELEVANCE

The Guam Historic Preservation Review Board plays a critical role in advising preservation policy and overseeing matters affecting Guam's cultural and historic resources.

Board members also serve as the Board of Directors for the Guam Preservation Trust, making these appointments significant to the administration of preservation grants, resource protection initiatives, educational programs, and community preservation projects throughout Guam.

The qualifications and expertise of Board members directly impact Guam's ability to preserve its cultural heritage while addressing contemporary development needs.

VIII. CONCLUSION

The hearing demonstrated strong support for the appointments of Michael W. Makio and Lynn Rosalie C. Leon Guerrero to the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board.

Beyond the appointments themselves, the hearing provided valuable discussion regarding the future of historic preservation on Guam, including public engagement, workforce development, preservation planning, and the protection of cultural resources.

The testimony reflected a shared commitment among stakeholders to strengthen preservation efforts while ensuring that Guam's history, culture, and heritage remain protected for future generations.
